



India Shines on Global Stage


Kush Maini Makes History at Monaco GP

Vocabulary Boost: What Is Petrichor?



Ever wondered why the air smells so fresh after it rains?

Petrichor is the word for the **pleasant smell** that comes when **rain hits dry** soil. It's caused by oils from plants and a natural compound called geosmin, made by soil bacteria. When rain falls, it releases these into the air, creating that unforgettable smell!


What Is Absolute Zero?

DIY DIARIES: Powered Night Light

Light from the Sun - A Simple & Sustainable Project



Want to explore how solar energy works while creating something useful and eco-friendly? This DIY Solar-Powered Night Light is a fun and educational way to reuse materials and learn about renewable energy at the same time.

You'll Need:

- 1 small solar garden light (available at hardware or gardening stores)
- 1 clean plastic jar or bottle with a lid
- Tape or glue
- Decorative items (optional stickers, paint, etc.)

Step-by-Step Instructions:

- 1 Carefully disassemble the solar garden light to remove the top part (the solar cell and LED module).
- 2 Attach this solar module to the inside of the jar lid using tape or glue. Make sure the solar panel faces outward.
- 3 Place the lid back onto the jar or bottle. Decorate the outside if you like.
- 4 Leave the jar outside or near a window during the day to charge.
- 5 At night, the solar-powered light will automatically turn on your homemade, eco-friendly night light is ready.

- 2 The basics of energy storage and LEDs
- 3 How to reuse everyday items in useful ways
