





HISTORY'S GREATEST INNOVATIONS

Who is the father of modern rocketry?

In 1926, American physicist Robert Goddard launched the world's first liquid-fueled rocket in Auburn, Massachusetts, marking a pivotal moment in the history of space exploration. This 10-foot-tall rocket, fuelled by liquid oxygen and gasoline, ascended 41 feet in just 2.5 seconds. He conceived many key concepts for later development of ballistic missiles, earth-orbiting satellites and interplanetary exploration.

100 Years of Quantum Science:

2025: The International Year of Quantum Science

- On 4th of February 2025, UNESCO inaugurated the International Year of Quantum Science and Technology, marking 100 years since the birth of quantum mechanics.
- · One of its most famous experiments, the double-slit experiment, shows how particles like electrons can act as both waves and particles. Strangely, when we observe them, their behaviour changes. This reveals a deep truth that observation affects reality at the quantum level.
- In 2022, the Nobel Prize in Physics was awarded to Alain Aspect, John Clauser, and Anton Zeilinger for proving quantum entanglement, where two particles remain connected no matter how far apart they are. To know more Click Here
- These discoveries have led to powerful technologies like quantum computing, encryption, and sensing, and the journey has only just begun.

Uncover Gifted Learners with Olympiad Potential

- Spot the Early Spark Look for scholars who show curiosity beyond the syllabus and ask perceptive questions that challenge their subjective understanding.
- Track Pattern Bright scholars frequently excel at relating trends, logical links, or topic connections others might miss, especially when in problem-solving tasks.
- Observe Learning habits Notice those who grasp complex conceptual topics, formulate new strategies and thrive on academic challenges without demanding repeated instructions.
- Encourage Independent Thinking Olympiad-ready minds frequently propose unique outputs, show action in subject literacy, and prefer figuring things out independently.

Become the Myth Buster of Your Students!

Myth: All snakes are venomous.

Only about 600 out of 3,000 snake species are venomous. Most snakes, like garter snakes and king snakes, are non-venomous and use constriction to catch their prey. While venomous snakes like cobras and rattlesnakes exist, they make up a small percentage of snake species. Most snakes are harmless and simply help control pest populations.

Surprising recovery seen in these East Antarctic glaciers

A surprising recovery has been observed in East Antarctic glaciers after years of melting. Recent research shows that between 2021 and 2023, the Antarctic Ice Sheet gained 108 gigatons of mass annually, reversing previous losses. This rebound is mainly due to increased snowfall, particularly in the Wilkes Land-Queen Mary Land region. While this offers temporary relief to global sea levels, experts caution it may not be a long-term trend.

DIY DIARIES: TURN CREATIVITY INTO CREATIVE LEARNINGS

The Disappearing Coin Trick



Want to wow your friends with real magic, no gimmicks, just skill?

You'll Need:

- 1 regular coin (any size works, but not too small)
- Your two hands
- A bit of practice in front of a mirror

Step-by-Step Instructions:

- Hold the coin between your thumb and forefinger of your dominant hand.
- Bring your other hand over as if to grab the coin.
- As your other hand closes, drop the coin into your original palm (don't pass it)
- Curl your original fingers slightly to hide the coin from view.
- Close the grabbing hand to make it look like it took the coin.
- Move the grabbing hand away and keep your eyes on it.
- After a moment, open the grabbing hand to show the coin has disappeared.
- Meanwhile, casually drop or pocket the coin from your original hand when no one is watching.

Tips for Success:

- Practice in front of a mirror to make it look natural.
- Don't draw attention to the hand that's holding the coin.
