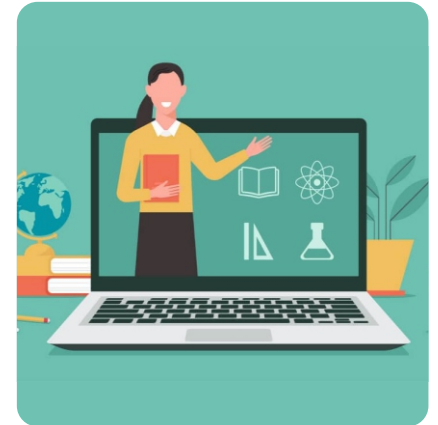

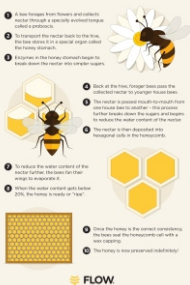

Why does milk spoil faster in summer?

Have you ever noticed that milk turns sour much faster during hot summer days?

This happens because milk provides an ideal environment for bacteria to grow. In higher temperatures, these microorganisms multiply rapidly and start breaking down lactose (milk sugar) into acids. This process changes the smell, taste, and texture of milk, making it sour and unsafe to consume.

In contrast, when milk is kept in a refrigerator, the low temperature slows down bacterial growth, helping it stay fresh for a longer time.

In simple terms: heat speeds up bacterial activity, while cold slows it down.

WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF

What would happen if you held your breath for 3 minutes?

After about **1-2 minutes**, your oxygen levels in the blood begin to drop, and **carbon dioxide** starts to build up. This causes dizziness, lightheadedness, and an intense urge to breathe. If you continue holding your breath, you could lose consciousness. Holding it for **3 minutes or longer** can lead to **brain damage** and other serious health risks.

Trained free divers can hold their breath for several minutes because their bodies adapt, but it's not safe to try without proper preparation. [Click here](#)

You blink about 15-20 times per minute!

Humans blink an average of **15-20 times per minute**, which means we blink around **28,800 times a day!** This simple yet essential action helps keep your eyes moist, clear of dust, and protected from irritants.

Even though it's an unconscious reflex, each blink plays a crucial role in maintaining healthy eyes. Your body is constantly working behind the scenes to **shield and care for your vision**—how awesome is that?

Space smells like burnt steak!
