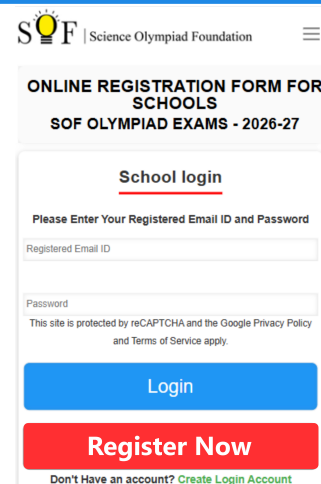
SOF Olympiads 2026–27: Registrations Now Open!

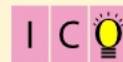

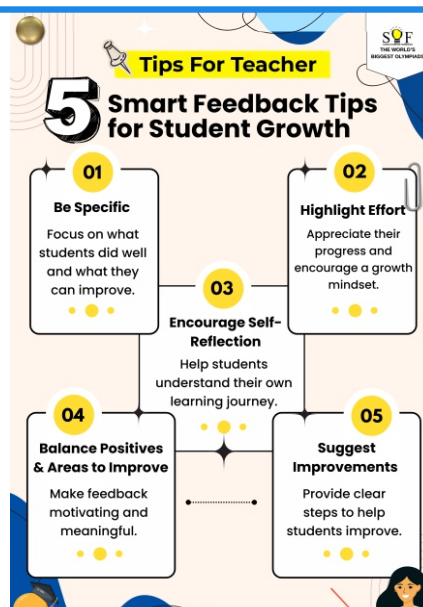
Why do potatoes turn crispy when fried?

Why do glasses help you see clearly?

Have you ever wondered how a simple pair of glasses can make blurry objects appear sharp? The answer lies in the science of **refraction**.

Eyeglass lenses bend light rays as they enter the eye, helping them focus correctly on the **retina**. This allows the brain to receive a clear image and helps people with vision problems see better.

Different types of lenses correct different vision issues - **convex lenses** help with farsightedness, while **concave lenses** help with nearsightedness.

A pair of glasses is a perfect example of how the physics of light helps improve everyday life!

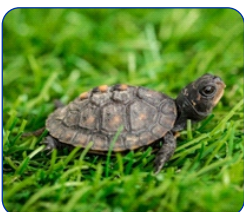

VOCABULARY BOOST

What does "Homeostasis" mean?

Meaning: The ability of a living organism to maintain a stable internal environment despite external changes.

Example:

- The human body maintains homeostasis by controlling its temperature through sweating in heat and shivering in cold.
- Plants maintain balance by regulating water loss through tiny openings in their leaves.
- Animals use homeostasis to keep essential processes like temperature, water levels, and energy balance stable.

Volcanoes Can Create New Land

When a volcano erupts, molten rock called lava reaches the Earth's surface. As the lava cools and hardens, it forms new layers of solid rock. Over time, repeated volcanic activity can build up these layers and create new landforms, including islands.

Volcanoes may seem destructive, but they also play an important role in shaping Earth's surface and creating new landscapes!

Astronauts See Multiple Sunrises Every Day

The **International Space Station (ISS)** orbits Earth at a very high speed, completing one orbit in about **90 minutes**. Because of this rapid journey around our planet, astronauts onboard can experience around **16 sunrises and 16 sunsets every day**.
