India's Top Achievements

- The Ram Mandir was successfully inaugurated on January 16, 2024, in Ayodhya, marking a historic milestone.
- ISRO successfully launched India's first manned space mission, Gaganyaan-1, in 2024.
- Mangalyaan-2 studied Mars, while Shukrayaan-1 explored Venus in December 2024.

India's Extra-ordinary Achievements in Sports

- India's cricket team won an ICC trophy after 11-year at the 2024 T20 World Cup.
- India won 6 medals at the Paris Olympics with Manu Bhaker's 2 Bronze medals.
- At the Paris Paralympics, India won 29 medals, including 7 golds, 9 silvers and 13 bronzes.
- India's 18-year-old chess player Gukesh D became the youngestever World Chess Champion, defeating China's Ding Liren.
- At 43 years, India's Rohan Bopanna became the oldest man to win a Grand Slam title in the 2024 Australian Open.

Narinder Singh Kapany

'Father of Fibre Optics'

This Punjab-born scientist's glorifying discovery of communication through optical fibres paved the way for the 'internet' as well as medical marvels like laser surgeries or endoscopic imaging. It was during his PhD at Imperial College, London that Kapany succeeded in transmitting images over a bundle of optical fibres and coined the term 'fibre optics' in 1955, opening up an entirely new portal of Optical Physics.


